A special meeting of the Congregation and Corporation of St. John's has been called for **Sunday, April 2**, immediately following morning worship, for two purposes:

First, we will be electing the congregational representatives for the 2017 Nominating Committee. The proposed candidates are: **Don Black**, **Janette Scott**, and **Libby Dalrymple**.

Second, we will be voting on a proposed amendment to the Bylaws of the Corporation. Article IV, Section 2 currently reads:

"The Board of Trustees shall consist of nine (9) individuals, three (3) of whom shall be elected annually from among the members of the Corporation. The term of said Trustees shall be three (3) years. All new terms shall begin on April 1. A Trustee upon completion of a full term may not be re-elected or appointed until one (1) year has elapsed.

The proposed amendment will change this section to read:

"The Board of Trustees shall consist of nine (9) individuals, three (3) of whom shall be elected annually from among the members of the Corporation. The term of said Trustees shall be three (3) years. All new terms shall begin on April 1. A Trustee upon completion of a full term may serve two consecutive terms, after which time he/she may not be re-elected or appointed until one (1) year has elapsed.
