## ST. JOHN'S OUTREACH PARTNER - CRUDEM FOUNDATION

Each month we highlight one of our mission partners, pray for the work that they do, and send them a letter of support signed by the congregation. This month we are focusing on Hôpital Sacré Coeur in Milot, Haiti. Operating under the auspices of the CRUDEM Foundation for more than 30 years, they provide critically important healthcare services to more than 250,000 residents of northern Haiti. The 200-bed tertiary care facility is one of Haiti's premier private hospitals, with two operating rooms, outpatient clinics, onsite clinical laboratory, pharmacy, labor and delivery rooms, pediatric wing, and blood bank. It performs an average of 2,800 surgeries, 2,200 newborn deliveries, 71,000 outpatient visits, and 7,500 emergency rooms visits each year. The hospital also offers nutrition and health education, including an HIV prevention and treatment program. Wanda Odom has the letter available for you to sign after worship.
