We are so happy that you have joined us for worship this morning! We hope that you experience the presence and love of Jesus Christ here with us today. COVID PRECAUTIONS

With Chester County’s move to “substantial spread,” masks are now required for all, regardless of vaccination status.

Initially, we will be using every other pew for seating (although there are no restrictions on capacity). If the number of worshippers exceeds our ability to do that, we will begin filling in the open pews as necessary.

We will not be passing offering plates. Instead, offering baskets are located at each of the entrances to the sanctuary, and you can place your offering there on your way in or out.

COMMUNION NEXT SUNDAY

Next Sunday (September 5) we will be sharing the Lord’s Supper together. If you are worshipping here, you will receive a bag with a piece of bread (gluten/nut-free is available) and a pre-sealed cup of juice on your way into the sanctuary. If you are worshipping at home via livestream, please be sure to have some bread and grape juice (or wine) on hand. However you are worshipping, we hope that you will share with us in this meal that reminds us of our unity in the one body of Christ.

ST. JOHN’S FALL ADULT EDUCATION

With the rise in Covid cases, we will not be having the “supper” portion of Supper at St. John’s, but we will still be offering a virtual class. **Starting on Wednesday, September 15 from 7–8 PM**, Patrick will be teaching a class via Zoom called “Mission Impossible? 
